AESI is a cultural association that has as its main target the promotion of human rights in politics and international cooperation. AESI wants to develop, with its activities, a real culture of cooperation among populations and Nations, respecting human being's dignity and identity. AESI wants to contribute to the training of those young students who are preparing themselves for a diplomatic career or a career in the European or International Institutions. More than 3000 students and young graduates have already taken part in the Seminars organized together with the Diplomatic Studies Club, the Centre for Advanced Defense Studies, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the European Commission and the European Parliament Information Office in Italy. AESI has also organized many International FORUMS in the Balkan Area (at the University of Sarajevo with EUFOR), in the Middle East (at USEK and Lebanese Universities in Lebanon with UNIFIL, with Israel and Palestinian Universities at UNTSO, at the Universities in Cyprus with UNFICYP), at the NATO Headquarters in Brussels, at the European Parliament, at the Italian Permanent Representation to the European Commission, at OCED in Paris and at UNOG in Geneva. Many of AESI students have already started a diplomatic career, or are working in the relevant offices of International Organizations. Among the speakers of AESI's events, there are more than 500 Ambassadors, representatives of the United Nations, the European Commission, the European Parliament, Generals and University Professors. AESI Publication "University Cooperation and Peace Process" has been presented at the Italian Embassy to the Holy See at Palazzo Borromeo on 6 July 2020. Ambassador Pietro Sebastiani and Prof. Massimo Maria Caneva welcomed to those who took part in the production of the Volume. The 240 pages publication collects, with an absolutely innovative and multidisciplinary editorial formula, many testimonies from the Diplomatic world, the Military Peace Forces and the Academic one. The three International Actors are part of the new "University Cooperation for Peace" strategy promoted by Prof. Caneva in over 20 years of cooperation programs in crisis areas such as: the Balkans (Sarajevo and Belgrade), Middle East (Beirut, Damascus, Jerusalem, Amman) and Eastern Europe (Baltic and Caucasus) and carried out in collaboration with the International Peacekeeping Forces of the United Nations and the European Union and NATO (UNIFIL, UNTSO, UNFICYP and EUFOR). The particular note will be the Messages and Videos of the Rectors / Professors of the Universities of the Middle East, Balkans and Eastern Europe, as well as by the Head of the United Nations Director-General in Geneva.
