

FORUM AESI JERUSALEM 20/25 MAY 2019

FORUM AESI in Jerusalem is an important opportunity of dialogue on the most important and urgent issues of the crises in the Middle East that sees deepening together Universities (Professors and Students) with Diplomats (Head of Missions of the United Nations, European Union) at Notre Dame Center in Jerusalem. The AESI FORUM European University Delegation will also meet the Nuncio of the Holy See at the Apostolic Delegation in Jerusalem.

University students and young AESI graduates will be the real and important protagonists of this FORUM from 20 to 25 May which will be composed of two major components:

A - first concerns the two thematic Seminars and meetings with Academics and Diplomats

B- second one regards the visit and the knowledge of places of the Holy Land and visits to Institutions and the United Nations, a very useful part to understand the socio-cultural and political context.

In addition to the Italians (AESI Professors and Students) some other Europeans and Middle Eastern Academics will also be present in the FORUM, as the Rector of St. Petersburg of the Russian, Vice Rector of Distance University of Madrid, the Rector of Hebrew University and Palestinian Professor of Political Sciences, Apostolic Administrator of the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem.

The FORUM AESI will be also organized with the collaboration cultural and social institutions in Jerusalem : Polis (Institute of Languages and Humanities) in Jerusalem and the Caritas Baby Hospital in Bethlhem.

DRAFT PROGRAM "THE VISION OF YOUTH ON THE ROOTS OF THE CRISIS IN THE MIDDLE EAST"

20 - 25 MAY 2019 JERUSALEM

One of the basic challenges of the 21st Century is assuring international peace and fostering development, in the light of the new World balance. Today, there are problems that can only be solved by action at the global level. New strategic thinking is required to approach global issues and advance "global public goods". Consequently, international communities must become protagonists of a new strategy to intervene in crisis areas and to promote peace, human rights and development with a strategy based on realistic and effective foreign common policy. Such a strategy must include the collaborative efforts of diplomatic, economic and peace forces actions, while being rooted in the common goal of development of a strong cooperation culture of solidarity capable of understanding local needs and providing quick and efficient solutions that are at once professional and respectful of human dignity. Such a strategy must rely on cultural expertise and include expert knowledge of the theoretical elements of crisis and development management and the capability to understand the real comprehensive needs of the populations, and their historical and cultural roots in order to give effective answers to them, and to promote peace and development even in the first phases of the interventions.
